COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT & OUTREACH

Opera UTEP has offered community performances and engagement since 2015. Beginning in fall 2020, Opera Workshop was certified as a **Community Engagement and Leadership (CEL)** course, entitling registered students to receive such designation on their transcripts.

El Paso Opera Junior Artists

2021, 2022, 2024

In collaboration with El Paso Opera, and funded in 2022 and 2024 by a UTEP Liberal Arts Community Engagement grant, I created an internship for selected UTEP opera students to perform with El Paso Opera Resident Artists on summer outdoor concerts and assist on mainstage productions alongside the professional stage managers, carpenters, electricians, stage hands, costumers, and artists.

Performances for Seniors and Charity

2015-present

Opera UTEP singers performed vocal selections at retirement communities and special events, supplementing the students' experience of performing in a variety of venues and circumstances.

Performances at High Schools

2017-present

Opera UTEP singers performed vocal selections at area high schools and answered questions about opera and UTEP. During the pandemic, outreach to schools was conducted via Zoom.

Invited Dress Rehearsals and Free Tickets to Performances

2016-present

Area schools are invited to reserve up to 50 free tickets to dress rehearsals or performances. During the pandemic, all performances were freely available on social media. I also wrote/edited Study Guides for students and teachers for these invited performances.

The Fox and the Cookie outreach performances

2023

Through a collaboration with the Center for Community Engagement at UTEP, I took UTEP singers to the YWCA, the El Paso Museum of Art, Don Haskins PK-8, and the Young Women's Leadership Academy to perform our world premiere children's opera by a Black female composer. We also hosted 800 students and teachers at Fox Fine Arts Recital Hall for two morning performances.

"Backstage with Opera UTEP"

2022

Through a collaboration with the Osher Lifelong Learning Institute (OLLI) at UTEP, I held four sessions over 10 weeks to educate audiences about the production process for a large-scale music theater work such as Opera UTEP's Spring 2022 production of *Luisa Fernanda*. Organized guest speakers (set and costume designers) and guest performers. Discussed various aspects of production.

UTEP Opera Scholars 2016–18

To engage with high school vocalists, I created a program for select talented high school soloists to perform alongside Opera UTEP students, receive coachings, and backstage learning opportunities.

Opera Scholars were additionally invited to join Opera UTEP singers and interested community members for live broadcasts from The Metropolitan Opera at local cinemas. An "opera breakfast" was held prior to the show, with occasional video conferences with Met Opera artists in New York City.

APPLIED VOICE INSTRUCTOR

I teach weekly one-on-one lessons for Performance, Music Education, and/or Commercial Music majors at the undergraduate and master's level. Regardless of major, students are encouraged to perform as often as possible, to practice their required repertoire under the pressures of public scrutiny.

SUPERVISED PERFORMANCES

In addition to required performances (voice area recitals, studio classes, and end-of-semester juries), my students are often selected for the Departmental and Honor Recitals, as well as guest artist master classes.

Degree Recitals and Pre-Recital Outreach

I guide undergraduate and graduate students through selection, preparation, and fine-tuning of their capstone project performance repertoire, as well as writing and formatting a comprehensive program with notes and translations for each piece.

For added degree recital preparation, I encourage and organize **pre-recital community outreach** performances at local senior centers, enabling the student and their pianist to have an additional runthrough of their program before performing for the UTEP faculty and audience, and providing uplifting entertainment for the community.

Voice Competitions

I encourage my students to enter various competitions for additional performance experiences and to receive feedback from outside experts. My students have performed in and won prizes and scholarships in competitions such as: NATS (Texoma and Rio Grande), Women's Club Voice Scholarship Competition, Canto del Norte Spanish Language Song Competition, and more.

Studio Recital

At the end of each semester I coordinate a recital for my applied students to perform one or two of their assigned repertoire in public, for friends, family and the community.
